The SNHS is an honor society bestowed upon students enrolled in the 10th, 11th or 12th grade. The requirements for membership include the following:

- A member must be a senior, junior, or sophomore.
- Participation in the Elite Scholars Academy science fair, Science night (TBA), and/or Science/Engineering Conference (TBA).
- A member must have and maintain a 3.5/4.0 grade point average. The member must also have a 3.5/4.0 average in all science courses.
- A **sophomore** member must be enrolled in AP Environmental Science.
- A **junior** member must be enrolled in at least one honors or AP science course during or prior to their 11th grade year. **Full time dual enrollment students must have taken Honors Physical Science or Honors Biology at Elite.**
- A **senior** member must have completed in at least one AP science course during their 12th grade year OR have completed TWO AP science and/or math courses prior to their 12th grade year OR is Full Time Dual enrollment.
- Membership Dues (\$20) include yearly dues and honor cord for expected graduation

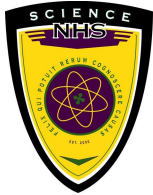
